

STUDENT PROTECTION POLICY HIGHLIGHTS - 2025-2026**

Every student has the right to an educational environment that upholds, cares for, respects, and protects their dignity.

1. **Child** is any resident of the UAE under 18 years of age.
2. **Child protection** includes all measures, steps, and actions taken to prevent, protect, and support students from the risk of maltreatment while under school supervision.
3. **Maltreatment** includes physical, emotional, or sexual abuse, neglect, exploitation, and bullying.
4. **Physical Abuse:** Any intentional act causing physical injury.
5. **Emotional Abuse:** Acts that make a student feel unloved and worthless affecting their mental and emotional development.
6. **Bad Touch:** When someone touches a student in a way that is not okay or makes them feel uncomfortable, unsafe, or scared.
7. **Neglect:** Failure of a parent or supervising adult to provide for a student's basic needs and rights.
8. **Exploitation:** Use of a student in work or activities for others' benefit, including labor, or involvement in gangs, harming the student's health, education, or development.
9. **Bullying:** Repeated physical, social, or verbal aggression by individuals or groups in positions of power against weaker students, causing physical or emotional harm.
10. **Cyberbullying:** Online bullying using communication or information technology to insult, threaten, slander, or blackmail someone.
