The academic year 2025–26 at Bhavans Al Saad Indian School was marked by significant progress, achievement, and an unwavering commitment to excellence. Rooted in the vision of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, founded in 1938 by Kulpati K.M. Munshi, the institution continues to uphold values of discipline, dedication, and holistic development. The expansion of Bhavans in the Middle East under the leadership of Shri N.K. Ramachandran Menon has strengthened its legacy of quality education.

The school community comprises 831 students, supported by 94 academic staff, 12 administrative members, and 10 support staff, working collaboratively to create an inclusive and enriching learning environment. The institution's commitment to quality is reflected in its 'Very Good' ADEK inspection rating and the ADEK Award for Outstanding Attainment.

Academic Achievements

The school recorded outstanding results in the CBSE Grade 10 and Grade 12 board examinations.

In Grade 10, Abhiram Krishna secured the first position with 99%, followed by Tanishq Pankaj Tardeja (97.8%) and Tanmay Deepak (97.4%).

Curriculum Development

A revised curriculum aligned with international benchmarks such as ASSET, TIMSS, PIRLS, and Olympiads was introduced. Science and Mathematics

curricula for Grades 1–8 were enhanced, while Kindergarten continued its experiential learning approach.

The integration of the Class Klap platform for Grades 1–5 has strengthened structured learning. A wide range of subjects and electives at the secondary and senior secondary levels ensures academic flexibility and career readiness.

Assessment and Student Attainment

The school follows a comprehensive assessment framework promoting continuous evaluation. The overall academic performance for 2024–25 stood at 79%, while Term 1 of 2025–26 recorded 76%, with a focus on further improvement.

International Assessments

Students demonstrated commendable performance in ASSET examinations:

- 84.8% of students in English scored above Stanine 6 (Outstanding)
- 71.60% in Mathematics achieved above Stanine 6 (Very Good)
- 70.10% in Science achieved above Stanine 6 (Very Good)

Certificates of Excellence:

- 14 students – Outstanding in English

In EARN 2024, the school achieved 88% in English, surpassing the UAE national average of 73%.

Teaching Quality Assurance

The school ensures high teaching standards through lesson observations, professional development, and participation in CBSE and external training programs. All teachers are enrolled in ADEK's 'Empowered' training program, with selected participation in the Intel® Skills for Innovation program.

Student Attendance

Student attendance averaged 94.06%, with a target of 96% through continued parental support.

Publications

The monthly newsletter *PRERNA* is regularly published, and the annual magazine *SOCH* will be released later in the academic year.

Collaborations and Partnerships

The school maintains partnerships with institutions such as Abu Dhabi University, Burjeel Medical Centre, Al Salama Dental Clinic, ISC, Sastra Pratibha, TMG, Magrudy, and IPF, enriching student learning experiences.

Co-Curricular Activities

Bhavans Fest featured 52 competitions, fostering diverse talents across Grades 1–12.

The Annual Athletic Meet saw enthusiastic participation. In interschool competitions:

The Boys' and Girls' Football teams secured second place in the Bhavans Cup Tournament.

The Girls' Volleyball Team achieved 2nd Runner-Up in the CBSE Cluster Competition.

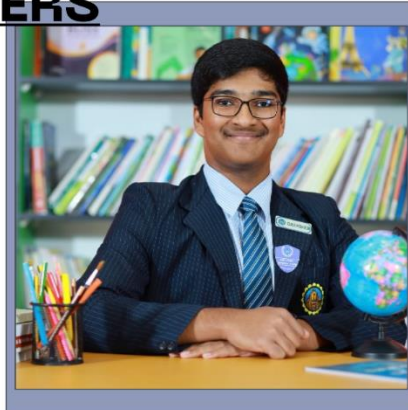
Conclusion

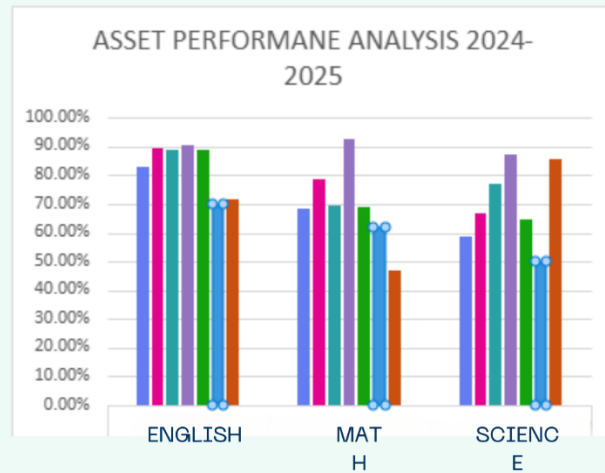

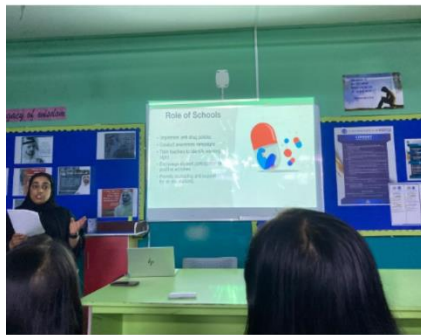
